Two years ago, God led me to begin writing a study-book that is geared towards non-believers, especially to those who have no concept of God. The name of the book is “One True God”. It is written in an interactive style with clear explanations of each point. From my former Buddhist’s perspective, I have been writing the book with Buddhists, Animists, Hindus and atheists in mind. Since I commenced it, my co-worker and I have been using it with both believers and non-believers. We find it very effective and the response to it has been very encouraging. People greatly appreciate the book because the explanations are very clear and it is ready to be used with believers and non-believers without much preparation.

I believe God wants me to have this book published and made available to people throughout Thailand. Also, I found that many of them want to use this study-book to spread the Gospel to their Asian friends throughout the world. This has encouraged me to have the book translated into English.

After much prayer and seeking of God’s will I decided to make a trip to the US to get help from my supporting church with the translation work. I landed in America on August 17. A few days after that, I began the translation project. God, in His faithfulness provided me with four godly volunteers from the church in Phoenix, Arizona, to help out with the translation and editing work. So far, the work has been progressing slowly, but surely. It may be quite a while before the 200 pages are complete even though we are working eight to nine hours per day. The translation work is difficult for me and for my friend who is helping me construct presentable English sentences. To avoid my back pain, I have been working while laying on the floor and using a portable, reclining tray that holds my computer. It has been working well...praise the Lord!



In the meantime, this book is also being translated into the Lahu and Chinese (Mandarin) languages. Please pray for all of us who are doing the work on this study-book as we greatly need God’s wisdom. Pray that the translation may be accurate, well done and completed in a timely fashion. We truly desire to see God use this book in a mighty way to reach many people for His glory.
